Call for Artists to Participate in WRAP Exhibit

What: Call for Artists – Wisconsin Regional Arts Program exhibit

December 15, 2011—Hartford, WI—For the fourth consecutive year, the Schauer Arts & Activities Center, in cooperation with the Kettle Moraine Fine Arts Guild, is hosting an exhibit and educational workshop as part of the 2012 Wisconsin Regional Arts Program (WRAP). Sponsored by the Schauer Center and the UW-Madison Department of Liberal Studies and the Arts, entries are currently being considered for inclusion in the exhibit. Chosen artwork will be displayed in the Suckow Family Art Gallery March 2-April 15, 2012.

WRAP is open to all non-professional artists 16 years of age or older. Artwork must be original and completed in the last two years. Entries will be juried and meritorious works will be displayed in a state exhibit in September 2012 at UW-Madison, where artwork is eligible for cash awards.

“The WRAP exhibit and workshop is a way for the Schauer Center to engage artists on a regional scale,” stated Schauer Center Executive Director Thomas Robbins. “These outreach initiatives provide artists in our community the opportunity to showcase their work, develop their talents, and meet fellow artists.”

As part of the program, the Schauer Center is offering a public lecture/demonstration by a local artist on Sunday, April 15, 2012. After the workshop, exhibiting artists will have a chance to discuss their work and receive critique from a professional artist.

Entry forms will be accepted via mail at the Schauer Center (147 N. Rural Street, Hartford) until Wednesday, February 15, 2012. Entry fee to exhibit artwork and attend the workshop is \$20; the public is invited to attend the workshop for a fee of \$5.
