NEW: STUDIO ONLY BALLET

These introductory ballet classes are perfect for young students to stay active in the morning opposite to half day school or a flexible daytime schedule. These classes are aimed at working on ballet technic and skills without the added performance requirements of our evening Performance Ballet program. Each class is offered in short 5- and 6-week sessions, perfect for your dancer to try ballet without the financial commitment of a yearlong class.

MOVE WITH ME

Ages 18 Months–4 Years with an Adult

This “Mommy and Me” style dance class is for walking babies and toddlers ages 18 months–4 years old with an adult. Students will develop coordination

and enhance motor skills through center and across the floor exercises with the assistance of their adults in an engaging class. This class will happen once a week for 30 minutes.

Students will be taught basic rhythm and musical qualities through direct instruction, playing instruments, and dancing. Creative Movement class happens once a week for 45 minutes. Creative movement is an encouraged addition to beginner and elementary ballet classes, but no prior experience is required.

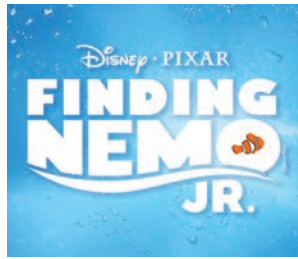

REHEARSAL INFORMATION

The first rehearsal and family meeting will be Thursday, October 23 from 4:30-6:30 pm, where cast, tech crew and families will receive detailed schedule information and read through the script. Specific rehearsal schedules, including which ensembles or roles will be called for rehearsals, will be shared bi-weekly. Rehearsals will run Tuesdays & Thursdays, 4:30-6:30 pm. and most Saturdays 9:00 am-12:00 pm. Evening rehearsal times will be extended in the months of December and January.

TECH CREW

Students interested in being a tech crew member and assisting with "behind the scenes" production work should register for the audition and indicate interest in tech crew. The audition will be an opportunity for potential crew members to meet the director and assist with the audition process by checking students in, running audio for the audition process, etc. Tech crew member positions are available for students 10 years or older. Tech crew members are not required to attend rehearsals in October or November. Tech crew members can plan to attend rehearsals beginning in December.

CAST & TECH CREW MEMBER TUITION
