Kindergarten

- 1. There are 3 red marbles and 3 green marbles on the table. How many marbles are on the table?
- 2. There are 4 small bunnies and 3 big bunnies. How many bunnies are there total?



Grade 1

- 1. The second recess in school is at 1 o'clock in the afternoon, which is 2 hours after the first recess. When is the first recess?
- 2. Grade 2 classes were going for a museum visit on Tuesday. They left the school at 10 o'clock in the morning and took an hour to ride the bus there. Then, they stayed in the museum for 2 hours and rode on the bus for another hour to come back to school. At what time did they arrive back at school?

Grade 2

It's harvest time on the farm.

1. There are 5 tomatoes but $\frac{2}{5}$ of them are rotten. Farmer throws out the rotten tomatoes and puts the rest in her basket. Cross out the rotten tomatoes.

Grade 3

- 2. 3 piles of clean white papers were stacked in the corner of his room. He decided to place these papers in paper envelopes which can hold 10 papers each. How many paper envelopes does he need if he has 120 clean white papers?

Grade 4

- 1. The train was scheduled to arrive at 5:10 p.m. However, it was delayed for 25 minutes. What time was it when the train arrived?
- 2. The bus departs the bus terminal every 2 hours. If the first bus is scheduled to depart at 10:35 a.m., when should the second bus depart?

Grade 5

Ashlee is making cookies for a holiday party.

- 1. Each batch of cookies mix need 0.4 cups of sugar and each batch can make 16 cookies. If Ashley is making 4 batches of cookies, how much sugar does she need?
- 2. Ashley found 2 boxes of sugar in the kitchen. The green box says 1.26 kg and the red box says 1.026 kg. Which box contains more sugar?


